## Sample Drug Regimen with Plan Options

Medication	Dosage	Quantity	Indication
Altace	5 mg	30	hypertension
Coumadin	5 mg	30	anticoagulant
FUROSEMIDE	20 mg	30	edema
Klor-Con 10	10 mEq	30	potassium replacement
Lipitor	10 mg	30	high cholesterol
Prevacid	30 mg	30	acid reflux
